

Introducing Scandock



This PC-free scanner allows you to use your smartphone to produce top-quality scans of documents, images, and other materials. Driven by free app software from your cell phone app store, Scandock not only makes the scan, but also crops it, color corrects it, formats it in jpeg or PDF, and saves it to your camera and/or sends it off as an email or text.

Scandock Instructions

- Step 1: Download free Scandock app from the app store. Just search “Scandock” and it should be the only one available.
- Step 2: Place object that you wish to photograph on the Scandock. If possible do not cover up the color strip at the top.
- Step 3: Place your phone with the camera positioned over the viewing hole facing down in the holder above the object. The Scandock should sense your phone and turn on the lights. If the lights did not turn on, touch the power button on the right hand light.
- Step 4: Open the newly downloaded Scandock app and scan your document
